The Tigard-Tualatin School District Board of Directors is seeking an educational leader with an outstanding record of achievement to serve as Superintendent beginning July 1, 2018. The School Board anticipates offering an annual base salary in the range of \$185,000 to \$210,000 plus benefits for the position.

The District

The Tigard-Tualatin School District serves more than 12,500 students in 10 elementary schools, 3 middle schools, 2 high schools, an online academy and an alternative school program. It is the 9th largest school district in Oregon and the 5th largest in the Portland metropolitan area. The district is large enough to provide a comprehensive academic program and small enough to maintain close connections in staff, students, parents and community.

Because of generous community support and responsible financial decisions, the district has provided quality educational programs and facilities for all students. In 2016 voters approved a \$291 million bond measure to complete major rebuilding projects at the district's three oldest schools, add classrooms for growth and for STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math), complete facility repairs and safety improvements district wide as well as purchase new and replacement textbooks and technology. In 2014 voters also renewed the district's Local Option levy to provide additional operating dollars to fund classroom teacher.

TTSD's outstanding district-wide tiered approach to literacy instruction has been recognized by the Oregon Department of Education, U.S. Department of Education's Office of Special Education Programs and the National Research Center on Learning Disabilities. The RTI (Response to Intervention) and EBIS (Effective Behavior and Instructional Support) programs are considered statewide models and have been recognized by the National Center for Educational Outcomes. Both high schools have been singled out for their high graduation rates and both take pride in their strong student test scores. The Community

The communities of Tigard, Tualatin, Durham, Metzger and Bull Mountain make up the Tigard-Tualatin School District. Until recently, these communities were among the state's most rapidly growing. Located next to the city of Portland, the district offers the benefits of suburban living within a vibrant metropolitan area. It is 90 minutes from the Oregon coast and an hour's drive to Mt. Hood. There is convenient access to the region's vast recreational, cultural and educational resources.

Neighborhoods are family oriented and revolve around the schools. With a population of 51,250, Tigard blends the amenities of a modern city with the community spirit of a small town. It is home to the Tigard hot air Balloon Festival, Broadway Rose professional musical theatre and has been named one of "America's Best 100 Cities for Young People". Tualatin has a population of 27,150. It offers 280 miles of award-winning parks, trails and natural areas as well as its own ArtWalk, a self-guided tour of the city's diverse collection of public art. Tualatin is also a recent America's Best Cities award winner. A strong base of parent, business and senior citizen volunteers also supports the schools. Each year more than 4,000 community members volunteer over 115,000 hours in district classrooms.
